- develop creative capacities through transcription, arranging, and composition projects as well as emulative and exploratory improvisation. Through creative application of traditional performance practices within contemporary music settings they will cultivate an individual artistic voice.
- develop a foundational knowledge of diverse music cultures through immersive academic study and collaborative experiences. In addition, students will regularly take part in community engaged learning.
